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Do you have a child that rides the school bus?

If your child is not riding the school bus at the end of the school day, parents/guardians **MUST** contact the bus driver with this new information. **Your bus driver is your first contact if your child is not riding the bus.**

Sometimes this message doesn't get to teachers or your child forgets and they end up on the school bus. If this is the case, then the bus driver can send your child to the school office.

Medication: Staff cannot administer over the counter medications at the school without written parental consent. These forms are available from the office. All medication should be in its original packaging. Pharmacies will split the prescription.

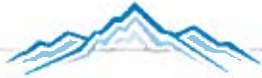


