

### men Lincon Con Con **ELIMINATE FLY-BYS!!! REDS FLASHING...NO PASSING** It is **illegal** and **dangerous** to pass a school bus when the red lights are flashing. KNOW THE RULES TWO-LANE, UNDIVIDED ROADWAY COL BOTH lanes must come to a complete stop and REMAIN STOPPED until the red lights have been deactivated. The penalty for DIVIDED ROADWAY, NO MEDIAN passing a school bus All 4 lanes must stop. when the red lights are flashing is \$567 and six demerit points.

Traffic to the rear of the school bus must stop.
